

Reagents

1. Purpose

This document details the requirements for outsourcing of testing and/or calibration services.

2. Summary

When needed, samples and/or equipment may be required to be sent to a laboratory outside of the control of Intermountain Forensics. The Forensic DNA Technical Leader is the ultimate authority on approving technical specification and/or laboratory qualifications previous to sending samples to the outsource laboratory for processing. This also applies to any instrument/equipment calibration and/or maintenance that is required offsite of the laboratory.

3. Procedure

- 1. Technical Assessment
 - a. The Forensic DNA Technical Leader is the ultimate authority for
 - i. Outsourcing samples
 - Before initiating sample processing, the DNA Technical Leader must evaluate the laboratory to ensure the outsourcing locations adhere to an acceptable level of quality.
 - 2. Where possible, an ISO accredited laboratory should be utilized.
 - If the case requires information to be sent that is sensitive in nature, a Non-Disclosure or Confidentiality agreement should be utilized.
 - ii. Any outsourcing that may impact NDIS/CODIS applicability must adhere to the Federal Bureau of Investigation Quality Assurance Standards that apply to outsourcing casework (Standard 17)
 - iii. External Calibration/Maintenance
 - When deemed necessary by the Forensic DNA Technical Leader equipment may be sent offsite for calibration.
 - 2. This is done at the discretion and direction of the DNA Technical Leader
 - a. Where possible, an ISO accredited laboratory should be utilized.
 - 3. A performance check may be necessary before returning the instrument to service.
 - b. As necessary as determined by the DNA Technical Leader:
 - i. Outsourcing casework will be reviewed for quality and appropriate testing results.
 - Note: often this outsourcing is work that staff cannot appropriately review (i.e. Genetic Sequencing for Genetic Genealogy)
 - ii. External outsourcing may be terminated for technical and/or quality issues.
 - iii. Evaluations and/or monitoring of external outsource entity may be put in place.
 - c. The DNA Technical Leader will document these assessments in an appropriate manner (memo, e-mail etc) and these will be stored in the appropriate management files.
